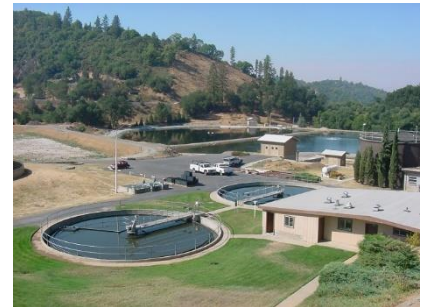

This opportunity is for full-time Utility Worker positions within the Operations Department. Initial placement in the collections, construction/maintenance, water distribution or raw water divisions will be based on the selected candidates' qualifications.

General Description:

Utility Workers perform a variety of construction, maintenance, and repair work on water and wastewater distribution, collection, treatment and disposal systems and facilities; assist in special projects and performs other duties as assigned.



Qualification Requirements:

- High school diploma or general education degree (GED)
- Must possess or obtain a Water Distribution or Collections System Maintenance certification within required, specific timeframe. *
- Must possess a valid Class A or B CDL, or obtain within a required, specific timeframe, and have a satisfactory driving record. *
- Ability to perform heavy manual labor and have relevant experience related to underground and above ground construction, working on installation, testing, maintenance and repair of pipelines and facilities.

Schedule: 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.; five consecutive workdays as assigned (may include one weekend day) with two consecutive days off, holidays, overtime and/or alternate schedule when required to meet the needs of the District. Must participate in the on-call standby rotation on a regular basis; therefore, must reside within an 18-mi radius of the District's main facility.
