## Interim General Manager

The Tuolumne Utilities District (TUD) board of directors is looking for a part time 30 hour/week Interim General Manager to assist with TUD's day to day operations and to work closely with the board and legal counsel until a new permanent GM is hired.

TUD has a dedicated board, a seasoned staff, and a hard-working team of 85 employees. Physical office hours would be flexible. All TUD personnel are experienced in videoconferencing and the office follows COVID-19 safety guidelines. Public meetings are currently video-conferenced.

Tuolumne Utilities District is a water and wastewater utility serving nearly 44,000 residents, including gravity-fed irrigation (raw) water to approximately 600 customers through an historic open conveyance system, in northern California's Tuolumne County within the Stanislaus River Watershed. Based in Sonora, TUD is centrally located in the Sierra Nevada foothills, mid-range between Yosemite National Park and Lake Tahoe. TUD is within the wildland-urban interface with the Stanislaus National Forest adjoining the district boundary to the east.

### Priority Projects of Interest

TUD has 2 long-range and complex projects that involve working with local, state, federal agencies and two federally recognized tribes. The Interim GM would be working closely with staff and legal counsel to keep these moving forward in a timely manner.

- PG&E acquisition and transfer of water rights and certain hydropower assets and licenses.
- California Valley Project Long Term Surface Water Contract development

Length of Appointment: Until a permanent General Manager is selected and on the job – approximately 6 months.
