



## TUD Service Line Inventory Survey

State law requires public water systems, such as Tuolumne Utilities District (TUD), to test for and remediate certain contaminants in drinking water, including lead and copper, and prohibits the use of any pipe, pipe or plumbing fitting or fixture, solder, or flux that is not “lead free” in the installation of repair of any public water system or any plumbing in a facility providing water for human consumption. The State Health and Safety Code Section 116885 requires TUD to compile an inventory of service lines in use in its water distribution system. TUD is asking for your assistance in compiling the Customer Side of this inventory. If you know or possibly know what kind of plumbing material was used to construct your homes service line, from the water meter to the inlet of the house, as well as the internal plumbing material and the age of your home, please fill out this survey below and return it to Angel Tarango, Regulatory Compliance Specialist.
